We share in your sadness at this sudden development and are here to offer our full support to the pupils and families affected by this closure.

Open for Drop-In Tours: We will be open for drop-in tours between 10 am and 3 pm for the remainder of this week, allowing you to visit our campus and see first-hand what Strathallan has to offer.

Extended Admissions Hours: Our admissions office will be operating with extended hours to accommodate inquiries and applications swiftly.

Waived Registration Fees: We are waiving the registration fee for all Kilgraston pupils to make the enrolment process easier.

Honouring Scholarships: We will honour existing scholarships up to 10%, ensuring that the financial commitments you've made are respected.
