

Policy Fee Concessions
As at September 2025

These Policy Fee Concessions are non-means-tested fee remissions, offered to all parents/pupils at Strathallan if certain criteria are met.

These remissions will only apply in full whereby the overall level of policy remission, plus any scholarship award, equals or is less than 40% of the full fee ie **the maximum level of cumulative Policy remission and Scholarship award is 40% to any one pupil**. Only by going through a means-testing process can the overall remission level for any one pupil be more than 40%.

These fee concessions do not extend to additional or extra charges.

Strathallian Remission

5% fee discount is given to all pupils of Strathallians.

Sibling Remission

Sibling remission is applied as follows, and only when the pupils are at Strathallan together in the core pupil or core International Studies Programme (ISP) programme:

<u>4 pupils at the School</u> 40% to the eldest child 20% to the second child 5% to the third child 0% to the youngest child	<u>3 Pupils at the School</u> 20% to the eldest child 5% to the second child 0% to the youngest child	<u>2 Pupils at the School</u> 5% to the elder child 0% to the younger child

Services Remission

For entry in September 2026, currently serving members of HM Forces who are in receipt of the Continuity of Education Allowance (CEA) are eligible for a fee remission, meaning families would only be required to pay the minimum 10% parental contribution of the gross full boarding fee.

Families eligible and in receipt of the full CEA should contact the Bursar's Office to discuss any remission that may apply to their fees. If you are interested in further information on support available for HM Forces members, please contact our Admissions team.

To give an indication of the parental contribution, the table below shows what the 10% contribution would have been based on the 2025 fees:
