Introduction

The following lists are designed for use by Boarding pupils. Day pupils will be expected to have all uniform items, but will not be required to have some of the items only necessary for those living at the School.

The pupil's name must be marked securely with nametaps on EVERY article (including boots and shoes). Laundry

Please note: laundry is uplifted twice a week. **It is anticipated that boarders have all items listed.**

The pupil's name must be marked securely with nametaps on EVERY article (including boots and shoes). For items bought through Schoolblazer, an option is available for nametapes to be automatically attached. On first arrival at Strathallan, give the Housematron two dozen spare nametapes. A charge will be made for any article that has to be marked at the School.

All articles should be suitable for laundry; uniform which requires to be dry cleaned will be charged separately at the end of each term where appropriate. **Duvet covers with plastic stud poppers or button fasteners will not survive the laundry! Velcro or tie fasteners please.**

Formal Dress

- 2 Pairs of kilt socks – suitably matching dark colour (cream for evening wear only)
- 1 Pair of garters with flashes – suitably matching colour
- 1 sporran
- 1 Kilt – family tartan or of own choice. The School Shop offers a made-to-measure service for the kilt and matching flashes (minimum 7 weeks order time)
- 1 Pair of formal tartan trews (optional for Upper Sixth form only - instead of a kilt) - family tartan or of own choice
- The School Shop has a limited supply of kilts, garters with flashes, kilt pins, kilt socks, plain black leather sporrans and may have some second-hand uniform.

Other

- 1 Pair of rugby boots *
- 1 Pair of Astroturf shoes for hockey *

Uniform Rules

Whether in school uniform, games or formal dress, pupils should observe the dress code. In particular:

- School Uniform – Shirts should be tucked in, top buttons done up and shoes polished.
- Formal Dress – Clothing should be clean and, where relevant, ironed. Kilt socks should be held up with garters. All members of the senior part of the School, except Heads and Deputy Heads of School and Heads of Houses, must have a kilt to be worn at Chapel, Speech Day and other formal occasions. Members of the Upper Sixth Form may wear formal trews as an alternative.
- Pupils visiting other schools should wear School uniform, including blazer, unless specifically instructed otherwise.
- Pupils accompanied by staff attending medical or dentist appointments in Perth may wear informal dress but must change from and back to weekday dress at the first practical opportunity before and after such an appointment.
- Games Kit should not be torn and must be clean for all school matches. Regulation shorts/skorts must be worn, shirts tucked in and socks kept up. All members of school cricket XIs should have whites and cricket footwear. All team practices and games sessions require regulation kit. Jewellery must not be worn with games kit. Please see Health and Safety section about safety equipment.
- During PE Classes, regulation shorts/skorts and polo shirt with school crest must be worn. Kit should not be torn and must be clean. Jewellery must not be worn with PE kit.
- Informal Dress should be clean and inoffensive.
- Hair should be brushed and clean, and extreme styles should be avoided. It should be of a natural colour and must not be obviously dyed. Boys hair should not be over the collar or close cropped. Boys and girls breaking these rules may be asked to return home until the situation has been corrected if it is not possible to sort the problem out at school.
- Boys should not wear jewellery either in School or in Houses. Girls may wear stud earrings (one set only). Only appropriate necklaces and bracelets may be worn with uniform.
- Excessive makeup is not appropriate with uniform.
