Aim for the sky

Clay target shooting is one of Scotland's fastest growing sports and here at Strathallan we have a proud shooting tradition going back many years. We are also the only school in Scotland to have its own purpose-built Compact Sporting clay pigeon shooting facility boasting nine fully automated radio-controlled traps.

Several of our alumni have gone on to represent Scotland at the World Championships and amongst our current pupils we have some of the best young shots in the country representing both Scotland and the school at the World Championships last summer, including a current Colts World Champion; Ali Turnbull.

Over the past twelve years we have been consistently placed in the top four at the British Schools' Championships as well as pre COVID-19 winning the Scottish Schools' Clay Pigeon Championships 13 times in the last 15 years. And since its inception three years ago, we have won the renowned Holland & Holland British Independent Schools Competition once and been runners up twice.

We hope over the next few pages you get an insight into the Shooting Academy at Strathallan and see first-hand how clay shooting is a sport close to the hearts of many in our school community.

After less than a year of taking up the sport, Strathallan student Molly H has helped the Scottish Junior Team win the British Open Junior DLT Clays Championships in Banbridge, Ireland.

The I6-year-old from Moray, who was recently named Ladies Non-International, Scottish Ladies High Gun and Scottish Ladies Champion at the Scottish DLT Championships, helped the junior Scottish side win their first British Open Junior DLT Championships since 1989.

Strathallan School pupil Molly H has become the first Scottish Woman to win the Welsh Open Championship Junior High Gun.

Molly said her win in Wales is a moment she won't forget, "It feels amazing, to know that I'm the first girl to win it and the first Scottish person, is an incredible achievement. I have a tradition of not looking at the scores whilst I shoot so I didn't know right until the prize-giving that I'd won. It was a memorable weekend."
