Most Decorated British Olympian

Duncan Scott MBE

Scott made history after winning four medals - more than any other British athlete at a single Olympic Games in Tokyo 2020 - and becoming Great Britain's most decorated swimmer in Olympic history.

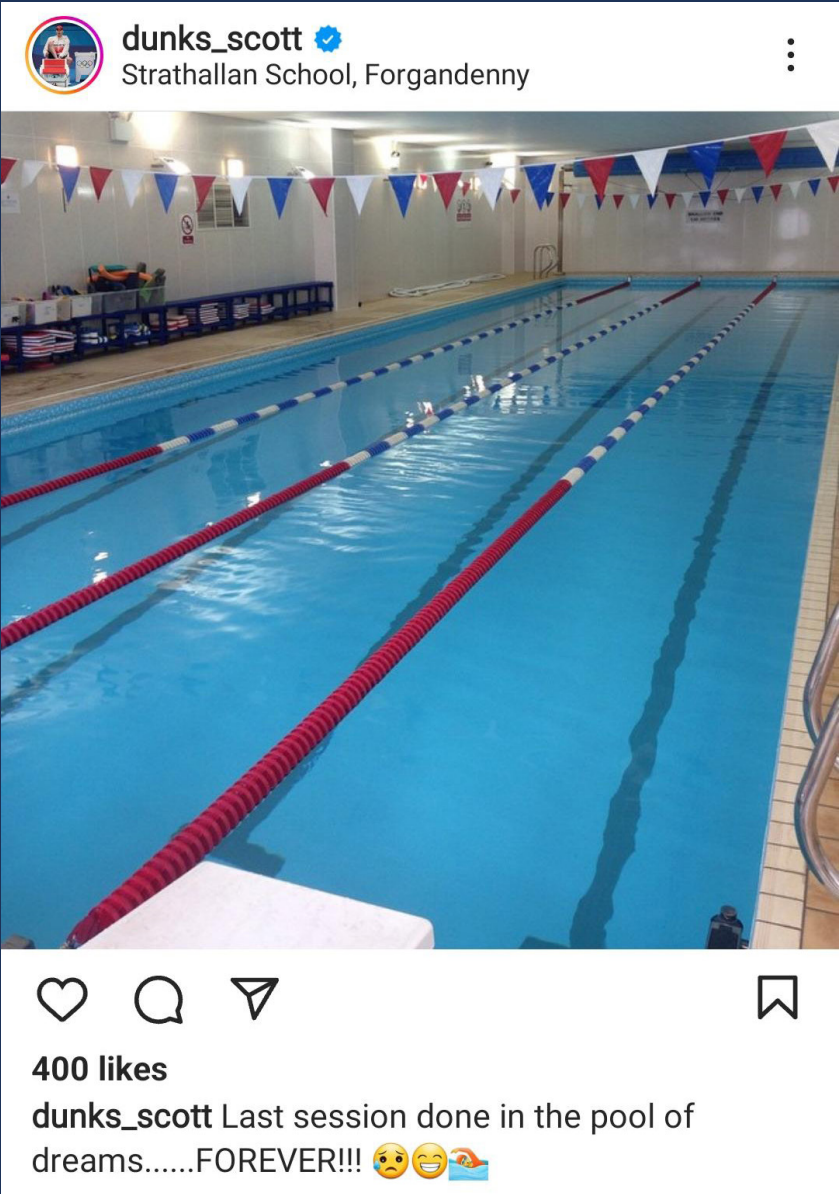
An all-rounder in the pool, he became the most decorated swimmer ever at a Commonwealth Games after finishing Gold Coast 2018 with six medals to his name.

Scott joined Strathallan School in 2008 on a sports scholarship. His most recent achievement has been to set a British and Commonwealth 400IM record of 4:09.18 at the British Championships in a time that would have won gold at the Tokyo Olympics.

Scott was awarded an MBE in the 2022 New Year Honours.
